Wine growing has been practised here for many centuries and is still all-present in Krems. Worth visiting is the historic centre, the Kunstmeile Krems, the museumkrems at the Dominikanerkirche and the Gozzoburg. Popular excursions are the Abbey with its magnificent Baroque church and the ruins, once the main Kuenring castle. The English King Richard I. was imprisoned in this castle from 1192 to 1193. From the ruin guests have a unique view across the Danube valley.
