



Walk the Egon Schiele Trail from his birthplace to the Schiele Museum and gain very private insights into the life of this prominent artist.

~ KREMS: MUSEUM TOWN ~

Krems – the art town delights visitors with an affinity for art: the Krems Caricature Museum is the only museum of its kind in Austria and displays incomparable works by Manfred Deix and others, while the new Lower Austrian State Gallery impresses with its spectacular architecture and art treasures from the State collection. In the »Kunsthalle Krems« art gallery, changing exhibitions by contemporary artists are on display and in the Frohner Forum, exhibitions featuring national and international artists contrast with works by the eponymous artist. Further to the east in Rohrau, you'll find the exclusive private collection of Spanish and Neapolitan painters from the 17th and 18th centuries in the Harrach gallery.

~ THE DANUBIAN LIMES ~


Discover the Limes, as the Ancient Romans called the Danube, and stop in Mautern and Tulln to discover the Roman museums there.

The Ancient Romans used the Danube as a natural border rampart and built whole towns and fortifications along the Limes on the Danube's southern shores. Roman ruins can still be seen in Mautern, Traismauer, Tulln and Zeiselmauer today.

~ EVEN THE ROMANS MADE WINE ALONG THE DANUBE ~

If you want to explore the 2000-year-old history even deeper, the Roman town of Carnuntum is definitely the place for you! Experience the world of the Ancient Romans in lovingly restored villas and live the Roman life in the reconstructed thermal bath. The »Gasthof zum Lustigen Bauern« inn will serve you dishes cooked according to recipes devised by the Roman gourmet Apicius.



Reach Danube

~ PUBLIC TRANSPORT ~

Nibelungengau Region: on the Westbahn line (between Salzburg and Vienna), regional trains run between Melk and Ybbs.

Wachau Region: from Vienna, take the train to Krems on the S40 (Franz Josef railway) or to Melk (Salzburg – Vienna line)

Tulln Danube region and Wagram: via the S40 (Franz Josef railway) between Vienna and St. Pölten, and Vienna and Krems. S4 via Stockerau to Absdorf-Hippersdorf (change to the S40 possible)

Römerland Carnuntum region: S7 from Vienna to Wolfsthal

Marchfeld region: S80 (Marchegger Ostbahn railway) from Vienna to Marchegg
